Vineyards

Featuring a combination of Robledo estate vineyards within the Sonoma Coast AVA, each planted with several clones per master grafting techniques. Clones Robledo Pommard 4, 777, 667, and 115 in adobe loam soils. Average vine age is 25 years.

Tasting Note

A Burgundian inspired California throwback. Light in color with hints of black cherry and ruby. Earthy, with a kiss of bright cranberry on the nose. Light tannins frame the delicate yet ripe fruit, with a slightly peppered finish.
